

Spring Vehicle & Tire Prep Checklist

O CHECK YOUR TIRE PRESSURE AND ADD AIR IF NEEDED. Make sure to

	check your tire pressure when the tires are "cool", or have not been driven on for several hours.
0	VISUALLY INSPECT YOUR TIRES. Check for bulges, cracks, or even sharp objects embedded in the tires.
0	CHECK TREAD DEPTH. Make sure it is at least 2/32nds of an inch deep.
0	CHECK WHEEL ALIGNMENT AND ROTATE TIRES. Have wheel alignment adjusted and tires rotated by a car maintenance professional.
0	CHECK AND TOP OFF FLUID LEVELS. Check engine oil, coolant, transmission fluid, brake fluid, power steering fluid, and windshield wiper fluid levels.
0	CHECK OR CHANGE WINDSHIELD WIPER BLADES. Blades that are cracked, warped or detached should be replaced.
0	CHECK ENGINE AIR FILTER AND REPLACE IF DIRTY OR CLOGGED. A clogged air filter reduces fuel efficiency and engine performance.
0	CHECK CABIN AIR FILTER AND CHANGE IF NECESSARY. Allergens like pollen can accumulate in the filter and continue to cause allergies into summer if the filter is not changed.
0	CHECK ALL LIGHTS. Walk around the vehicle and check that headlights, taillights, brake lights, turn signals and hazard lights all work. Check interior lights and replace bulbs if needed.
0	CLEAN THE VEHICLE EXTERIOR, WINDOWS AND MIRRORS. Clean off any accumulated mud, grime or other debris from winter.

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0	VACUUM THE INTERIOR OF YOUR VEHICLE AND REMOVE GARBAGE
	OR CLUTTER.

O **CHECK YOUR EMERGENCY KIT.** Replenish any items that have been used or have expired.
